Appeals

LowPass Safety NetLocal Diploma)

Thelow passsafety net option allows a student with a disability to meet the testing requirements for a local diploma. Eligible studes must score between 55 and 64 on one or more of the required Regents exams.

AppealOption (Local Diploma)

LOTE Credit Exemption

Students with disabilities may be excused from the requirement for 1 credit in LOTIE indicated on their IEP. They must still earn 22 units of credit to graduate. Students who are declassified in grades 9 12 whose last IEP included a LOTE exempt on are also eligible A LOTE exempt student who seeks a Regents diploma with advanced designation does NOT have to complete the 5 unit sequence in the Arts of Cto meet the exam requirements for the advanced diploma.
