The firstocally developed Checkpoint A assessments based on the revised standards last the assessment provided by NYSEDDI be administered in June 2025.

With only one year remaining before the phaise of the standards implementation beins, now is the time for all worldlanguage teachers to become familiar with the revised standards and the instructional shifts that underpin their successful implementation. Since the revistant dards were dopted by the NYSB oard of Regents in the Spring of 2021, the Office Bidfingual Education and World Languages (OBENASL) een creating and disseminating professional learning instructional planning resources and guidance.
