Intentional sequencing of rich thematic units creates learning experiences that are relevant to learners' interests and appriate to checkpoint proficiency targets. Vertical articulation spirals poficiency development and recycles and reinforces **High**uency vocabulary and grammatical structures. In this session, participants will examine templates to help analyze and sequematic units across the checkpoints. Presenters will also demotestize between the used to assess how well the curriculum addresses the revised NYS Learning Standards for World Languages, their embedded language functions, and NYS World Language themes and topics.
